The Bosco House team and Mrs Hibbert will be delivering the Hampers early next week. A huge thank you to all our generous Pupils, Teachers and their families.



### **Geology Christmas Lecture**

From battle of the bands and mixing with staff at the leavers ball to delivering the Geology Christmas lecture 25th anniversary special, Dr Matt Loader has come along way since leaving St Bede's in 2006. Matt is the son of the former Geology Master Pete Loader who lead the Geology Department for almost 40 years and so it seems fitting that he is returning for our 25 anniversary special a quarter of century after his father started the series in 1995.

After leaving St Bede's Matt completed his undergraduate degree at the University of Bristol with a year in America at the University of California (Santa Barbara). After a year out he began his PhD at Imperial College London focusing on the evolution of magma and mineral ore deposits which they form. Matt is currently a post doctorate researcher at the National History Museum where he is currently working on the 'Fertility Fingerprints' project, funded by Quantum Pacific Exploration (QPX). This project, which will run for 2-3 years, focuses on the mineral chemistry of key phases within porphyry Cu deposits, with the aim of developing them as tools for exploration.
