

An honest half time team talk and a change in attack saw St Bedes very own Iniesta Markel get on the ball and cause havoc for the MGS defenders with his fine passing range in the final third. A goal mouth scramble in MGS box saw a handball on the goal line. Penalty awarded and dispatched precisely by Theo into the bottom left corner. Just moments later the third penalty of the game was won after a driving run into box from Fidele who was fouled. Expertly finished by Theo once again into the same corner with the same result. The defence was looking strong with Blaine adding calmness and reassurance, supported by Harry who was magnificent, both were flanked by the solid Joel and Billy who has established himself well into the team.

Just like London buses and the goals didn't stop arriving. The team then took the lead after some terrific defensive work to win the ball back by captain Luigi on the left who found his composure to cross to the back post for Tom to attack and tap home. 


A Message From The Queen




