A Digital Revolution to Help Students to Reach Their Potential

From the start of the pandemic, teaching and learning has changed, and St Bede's has taken on the challenge of this **new educational scenario**. Due to the current situation, we have grasped this opportunity to continue improving and innovating, launching an important **digital transformation**.

Although face-to-face teaching is completely irreplaceable, during the last year our students were able to continue their **learning and personal growth journey** thanks to the great effort of teachers, parents and students themselves, and thanks to technology.

After an extensive study considering the best educational, methodological and technological options, we have decided to adopt the platform **Google Workspace for Education** for the next academic year 2021/2022. All pupils will use **Chromebooks** from Prep 3 through to Upper Sixth.

Substantial improvements will be made to **improve technological facilities** in classrooms and refurbish spaces that promote collaboration and experiential learning.

Each student having an electronic device offers endless learning opportunities. At St Bede's we recognise the importance of writing and creative work in learning, and this will continue to be the case. The purpose of technology in the classroom will be to **enhance learning**, by using it as a tool and not as an objective.

Google Workspace for Education is totally different from Google personal accounts. **No tracking of pupils' data.**



Google Workspace tools + Chromebooks = **a connected learning environment** in the cloud. Real time **collaboration** and advanced **communication** between teachers and students.



We will install **supervision and control profiles** on students' devices. Both teachers and parents monitor and control activity.
