Many students are interested in the idea of a 'gap year' between leaving school and starting university. This could include gaining work experience, travelling, or learning new skills.

Some of the ideas that have been suggested by our community include...

A year in business. The Engineering Development Trust (EDT) offers a Year in Industry (YINI) Placement scheme which helps place students into paid 12-month long placements into all areas of engineering, science (particularly physics), technology/electronics, business, marketing and finance across the UK.
